

new system features

USB/IPOD® INTERFACE (if so equipped)

- The USB jack is located in the center console under the arm rest.
- When a compatible USB memory device or iPod[®] is plugged into the USB jack of compatible audio files stored on the device can be played through the vehicle's audio system.

NAVIGATION SYSTEM (if so equipped)

- Your Navigation System can calculate a route from the current location to a preferred destination. The real-time map display and turn-by-turn voice guidance will lead you along the route.
- The Navigation System will continually update your vehicle's position. If you have deviated from the original route, it will recalculate the route from your current location.

LOOSE FUEL CAP

- A LOOSE FUEL CAP warning message will display in the vehicle information display
 when the fuelfiller cap is not tightened correctly.
- The warning message will disappear when the vehicle detects the fuel-filler cap is properly tightened and the reset button
 is pressed.
- If the cap is not properly tightened, the Malfunction Indicator Light ENGINE may illuminate.

TIRE PRESSURE MONITORING SYSTEM (TPMS)

- A CHECK TIRE PRESSURE warning message will display in the vehicle information display of and the TPMS light will illuminate when one or more tires are low on pressure and air is needed.
- After tire pressures are adjusted, drive the vehicle at speeds above 16 MPH (25km/h) and the warning and indicator light will disappear.
- When the low tire pressure warning light flashes for approximately 1 minute and then remains on, the TPMS is not functioning properly. Have the system checked by a NISSAN dealer.
- Tire pressure rises and falls depending on the heat caused by the vehicle's operation and the outside temperature. Low outside temperature can lower the temperature of the air inside the tire, which can cause a lower tire inflation pressure. This may cause the low tire pressure warning light to illuminate. If the warning





light illuminates in low ambient temperature, check the tire pressure in all four tires.

NISSAN INTELLIGENT KEY™ SYSTEM (if so equipped)

The NISSAN Intelligent Key™ System allows you to lock or unlock your vehicle, open your liftgate and start the engine.

- To lock or unlock a door, push any door handle request switch 01 once.
- Push any door handle request switch 01 within 5 seconds of unlocking the door and all other doors will unlock.

NOTE: It is important to make sure the Intelligent Key is with you (that is, in your pocket or purse).

POWER SEAT ADJUSTMENTS (if so equipped)

- Push the control switch 01 forward or backward to slide the seat forward or backward.
- Push the switch 22 forward or backward to adjust the angle of the seatback.

SEAT LIFTER (if so equipped for driver's seat)

To adjust the angle and height of the seat cushion, push the front or rear end of the switch of up or down.

OUTSIDE MIRROR CONTROL SWITCH

- Turn the control switch right or left to select the right or left side mirror.
- Move the control switch up, down, right or left to adjust the mirror angle.

STARTING/STOPPING THE ENGINE (NISSAN Intelligent Key™ models only)

- Depress the brake pedal.
- Push the ignition switch in.
- Confirm the Intelligent Key system warning light is illuminated green.
- Turn the ignition switch to **START**.

TURNING THE ENGINE OFF

Move the shift lever to the P (PARK) position, apply the parking brake and turn the ignition switch to the LOCK position.

HEADLIGHT CONTROL SWITCH


- Turn the headlight control switch 1 to the DOE position to turn on the front parking, side marker, tail, license plate and instrument panel lights.
- Turn the switch 11 to the 10 position to turn on the headlights.

WINDSHIELD WIPER SWITCH

- Move the lever to the following positions to operate the windshield wipers:
 - Intermittent (INT) Front wipers operate intermittently.
 - Low (LO) Front wipers operate at a continuous low-speed.
 - High (HI) Front wipers operate at a continuous high-speed.
 - Rear Wiper (REAR) Twist the end of the lever to operate the first (INT) or second (ON) speed settings for the rear wiper.

AUTOMATIC CLIMATE CONTROLS (if so equipped)

01 FAN SPEED CONTROL DIAL/A/C BUTTON

- Turn the fan speed control dial \$\frac{1}{2}\$ to the left (low) or right (high) to control fan speed.
- Turn the dial all the way to the left to turn the system off.

02 TEMPERATURE CONTROL DIAL

■ Turn the temperature control dial 02 to select the desired temperature. Turn the control dial to the left for cooler air or right for warmer air.

03 DEFROSTING/DEFOGGING FRONT AND SIDE WINDOWS

■ Turn the air flow control dial 04 to the front window defroster mode 111.

05 REAR WINDOW AND OUTSIDE MIRROR (if so equipped) DEFROSTER SWITCH

Push the rear window defroster switch to turn the system on or off.

FM/AM/XM®* RADIO WITH CD PLAYER (if so equipped)

01 VOL/ON•OFF CONTROL KNOB

- Press the VOL/ON•OFF control knob to turn the system on or off.
- Turn the **VOL/ON•OFF** control knob to the right or left to increase or decrease the volume.

02 TUNE/SCROLL/AUDIO KNOB

■ To manually tune the radio, turn the TUNE/SCROLL/AUDIO knob left or right.



PARKING BRAKE

■ To apply, firmly depress the parking brake pedal 01 .



To release, firmly press the foot brake 02, then press the parking brake pedal 01 and the parking brake will release.

LIFTGATE RELEASE

■ Unlock the liftgate by pressing the button on the keyfob twice.



To open the liftgate, push the liftgate release switch and pull up to open.

FUEL-FILLER DOOR

- The fuel-filler door is located on the right, rear side of the vehicle.
- To open the fuel-filler door, pull the left side of the door.

CRUISE CONTROL

- The cruise control system enables you to set a constant cruising speed.
- The system will automatically maintain the set speed until you tap the brake pedal, accelerate, cancel or turn the system off.
